- 3. I understand that enrolment for a course together with the payment of the required fees creates a binding Agreement to follow the course and to pay the full fees in the prescribed manner.
- 4. I understand that I am required to bring my student card at all times while on the premises and failure to do so may result in me being asked to leave the premises.
- 5. I undertake to abide by all academic, administrative and examination rules, regulations and policies currently in force or as shall be changed from time to time by ATC.
